



## **2024 Men's Matches Competition Rules**

**Tee-Markers:** Men's Matches are from Blue Tees (including 2-man Scramble & Best Ball). Senior Men's Matches will be played from the White Tees.

**Local Rule:** If a player loses a ball, then they can choose to replay the shot with 1 penalty stroke incurred or can drop the ball 2 club lengths from the point of entry with 2 stroke penalty.

*Example: Player loses a ball after his tee shot goes down right side of Hole 1. They drop 2 club lengths from point of entry and play their 4<sup>th</sup> shot into the green.*

**Bunkers:** We will play the bunkers as lift, rake, and place.

### **Golf Course Staking & Maintenance Areas:**

- Lateral hazards are defined by RED stakes
- Water hazards are defined by YELLOW stakes
- Maintenance areas are defined by ORANGE stakes\*

**\* ONLY MATCHES PLAYED ON TUESDAY NIGHT WILL PLAY THE WHOLE GOLF COURSE AS A LATERAL HAZARD.**

*\*\*A player is entitled to free relief if they hit a ball into the maintenance area right of Hole 2.*

*\*\*\*A player must find their ball in the maintenance area on Hole 7 (right of maintenance path) to be entitled to FREE relief. Closest point of relief outside of the maintenance area plus 1 club length is provided. Ball must be dropped from knee height.*

### **Electrical Standards on Hole 18:**

- A player who hits a shot that strikes the electrical standards on hole 18 must replay the shot from the original position with no penalty.
- A player is entitled to line and sight relief from the electrical standards on 18 if they are going to interfere with a shot into the green.

**Rule 3.3: Playing Two Balls When Uncertain What To Do** – A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty. Please announce if Rule 3.3 has been used during play when signing your scorecard at the end of your round.

**Playing Rules:** Modified SUMMER Rules. Modified Summer Rules will mean that you can only roll your ball within 6 inches of its original position in your own fairway.

*\*Please note, **Free Relief** will be provided for any ball finishing in a dried & cracked surface. Must be agreed upon by all competitors in the group.*

→ Daily course conditions could change due to weather, and this will be posted on the 1<sup>st</sup> tee or in the pro-shop.
